Gopher Resource LLC's Policy for Conflict Minerals

Gopher Resource LLC is committed to ensuring that the products it sells do not incorporate "conflict minerals," which are minerals smelted into tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold sourced from entities which directly or indirectly finance conflict in the Democratic Republic of Congo or adjoining countries.

Gopher Resource LLC intends to fully comply with the requirements of Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act, which requires that Gopher Resource LLC perform due diligence into the sources of such minerals, and disclose the results of such diligence.

Gopher Resource LLC requires its suppliers to:

- perform sufficient due diligence into their respective supply chains to determine whether products sold to us contain tin, tantalum, tungsten or gold, and, if so, whether and to what extent those metals are sourced from conflict-free smelters;
- report to Gopher Resource LLC the results of such due diligence to enable Gopher Resource LLC to comply with its legal obligations and policy goals; and
- commit to being or becoming "conflict-free," so that any such metals are sourced only from conflict-free smelters.
